## ALERT LEVEL 1

We would like to have your things ready for you to help make the transaction safe, speedy and efficient. **NB This applies particularly to those who have ordered lectionaries, almanacs, diaries, prayer and hymn books etc. Invoices will be prepared in advance to minimise contact time.**
