Launch of ACSA's "Children's Ministry" by Archbishop Thabo Makgoba.

There was a huge amount of excitement during the preparations of **Anglicans Ablaze 2020** as we prepared to launch a "**Children's Ministry**" component for the very first time. Anglicans Ablaze, which is hosted by Growing the Church, always had a youth component for young people from 13 years upwards. Now we were going to cater for the 5 to 12 year olds, beginning with an intake of 100 children. The intention was not only to care for, and minister to children, but also to provide equipping for parents, Sunday School Teachers and clergy in the finer details of what it means to raise children who will become life-long disciples of Jesus. Then COVID-19 happened. But, we did not give up on the vision that we believe God gave us!

With this in mind, GtC & AA Liaison Bishop, **Tsietsi Seleoane**, and the GtC board, mandated **Revd's Thabang Bengani** and **Bulelwa Sihlali Woolley** (Board Members) and Revd Bruce Woolley (Board Advisor & Tech Manager) to draw together an ACSA team to transform the vision into a children's online ministry, under the oversight of GtC & AA Director, Revd Trevor Pearce. We asked, "How can we not only survive, but thrive in spite of

the current challenges?" And the Anglicans Ablaze Children's Ministry was born and the vision was re-kindled!
