## > NOTICE TO THE DIOCESE:

We had a Special Chapter meeting on the 18<sup>th</sup> March 2020 in regard to the Archbishop's statement in view of the State President's announcement of regulations to curb the spread of the Coronavirus in South Africa.

Firstly, we endorse the latest update by the Archbishop which is attached. Please adhere to it.

Secondly, this is what we are advising members of the Diocese to do:

Request the Church Council members to be assigned the responsibilities to assist during services, checking the numbers and helping people sit a metre apart.

Guilds to spread themselves for service.

Good Friday – minimum of an hour in between the service
Maundy Thursday – have more than one service where numbers exceed 100
Maundy Thursday - Renewal of vows for clergy only
No foot washing service – Eucharist in one kind
Baptisms to be suspended until further notice.

  - get the permission of the Rector/Priest in Charge to transport youth especially those 18 years and under
  - complete the Diocesan Indemnity forms and hand over to Churchwardens; and
  - send a list of those young people to the Bishop's office prior to the trip/journey. This is to protect all those in youth ministry. Failure to do so becomes your own liability.
