Services for Holy Week:

Important information regarding the services starting on Sunday.

I promised to send information concerning the services starting from Palm Sunday. With the warning of the 3rd wave of the virus, and with some countries in the Northern Hemisphere experiencing the 3rd wave, we need to be very careful and play safe. The 2nd wave was devastating with many infections and deaths. We have just under 200 000 frontline workers who have been vaccinated and we still have a long way to go. So we have to continue to follow the protocol: wearing of masks, washing hands/ sanitizing, social distancing and going out only when necessary.

Palm Sunday: There will be NO processions. Please follow the service without procession from the APB page 174. Congregations can have the palm branches in the church as a symbol. I suggest that each person takes a piece of palm (no palm crosses) as they register. Make sure that the register of attendance is done.

Services in Holy Week Monday to Wednesday can be done. Please keep to one hour.

Maundy Thursday: Chrism Eucharist for Clergy at the Cathedral at 10h00.

Maundy Thursday evening service- NO WASHING OF THE FEET as this is likely to cause touching, albeit unintentionally. Parishes are encouraged to

consider innovative ways to show the humility and servanthood which Christ demonstrates in this action, in other ways.

The stripping of the altar to be done following strict health protocols. This service may likely be a little longer but should not exceed 1 hour 20 minutes maximum. The longer people are in closed spaces, the higher the risk of infection.

Good Friday: No veneration of the cross and no 3 hour service.

Saturday: Paschal candle may be lit

Easter Sunday:

All the above services not to be longer than 1 hour 20 minutes

ALERT LEVEL 1
